## FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Dear Sisters in Christ,

Here we are only 6 weeks away from the 44th Biennial Clergy-Laity Congress in Boston, Massachusetts! The theme is *All Things are Possible to the One Who Believes in Christ* (Mark 9:23). This Congress is hosted by the Holy Metropolis of Boston and His Eminence Metropolis Methodios. Your NSP Board and the Boston Metropolis Sisterhood have many exciting things planned for you.

Many of you have asked for Clergy-Laity information. The Clergy-Laity committee has been hard at work trying to accommodate everyone's needs. Unfortunately, not every thing is finalized, thus, no Clergy-Laity schedule is yet available. We decided to prepare this Clergy-Laity newsletter with the information we have. Updated information will be available via email and our NSP website ([www.nsp.goarch.org](http://www.nsp.goarch.org)).

If you have not already done so, please go to [http://nsp.goarch.org/about\\_us/clergy-laity-congress-2018](http://nsp.goarch.org/about_us/clergy-laity-congress-2018), register for the Clergy-Laity Congress, and book your hotel. There are special rates for presvyteres (\$500) and retired (not serving a parish) priests and presvyteres (\$125). You have a choice of hotels—Boston Marriott Copley Place and Westin Copley. The Clergy-Laity meetings will be held at the Marriott. Once you register and book your hotel, you can pretty much relax and wait to receive communication from us.

Our NSP schedule will pretty much be the same as in the past. The Congress will begin with an Hierarchal Divine Liturgy on Sunday, July 1, 2018, at the Greek Orthodox Cathedral of the Annunciation. The official opening of the Congress will take place at the Marriott with the Keynote Address by Archbishop Demetrios.

On Monday afternoon, we will meet in our room, have an Icebreaker, Nominations, Minutes of the 2016 Clergy-Laity NSP meetings, and the President's, Benevolent Fund, and Corresponding Secretary's reports. Then, we will have time for individual metropolis meetings and pictures. On Monday evening, we will have our Benefits Presentation and Q&A.

We will meet on Tuesday morning for our Treasurer's report, Metropolis and Committee reports, and to vote on a 2020 Nominating Committee. In the afternoon we will participate in HCHC Day (on campus) and enjoy a barbecue together. There will be a Congress cultural event at the hotel that evening.

We will start off Wednesday morning with Fr. Nicholas and Presv. Roxanne Louh who will facilitate our workshop—*Renewing You*. We will then continue our business meetings.

On Thursday morning, we will have elections and free time from 9:00am-9:30am. We will then announce the results of the elections, announce the Metropolis Representatives, tend to any other business, take a break, and then go on our presvyteres outing—a Trolley Tour of Boston.

Please take the time to thank Leadership 100 Chairman, Argyris Vassilious, Executive Director, Paulette Poulos, and all the members of L100 for their donations to our Clergy-Laity workshop, our clergy family event, and our retreats. They make these events possible. Thank you, L100!

# NSP ELECTIONS



Elections will take place during Clergy Laity this year. Nominations will be accepted by the nominating committee prior to Clergy Laity and on the first day of meeting which is Monday, July 2, 2018 (per section 4). If you are interested in running for an office, please be advised of the duties below. To submit your name for the election, contact Alice Noplos at [anoplos@comcast.net](mailto:anoplos@comcast.net).

## **Section 4:**

*The Nominating Committee shall accept nominations for each office prior to the Clergy Laity Conference and also from the floor at the first NSP business meeting of the Clergy Laity Conference, and present the names of all qualified nominees to the body of Presbyteres present at the NSP Conference held at the Archdiocesan Clergy-Laity Congress.*

When deciding to run for an office, please be advised of the responsibilities and qualifications of the Executive Officers:

## **The President**

The President shall be elected to a two-year term and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

The nominee for President shall have served at least one two-year term on the NSP National board.

The President shall be responsible for convening at least one annual meeting of the NSP Board.

The President, after each Archdiocesan Clergy-Laity Congress, shall submit the names of the members of the new NSP Board to the Archbishop and to the Hierarch of each Metropolis.

The President shall be one of the four administrators of the APC (Archdiocesan Presbyters Council) and NSP Benevolent Fund, and, along with the APC President, is responsible for generating the annual appeal letter.

The President shall be a member of each standing committee and is responsible for conferring with the committee chairmen of the various NSP projects.

The President shall represent the NSP at Archdiocesan functions whenever possible. If she cannot attend, she shall ask the Vice-President or another representative to attend. The President shall be an ex-officio member of the Archdiocese Benefits Committee and if appointed by the Archbishop, shall be a member of the Archdiocesan Council and National Philoptochos Board.

The President shall oversee that the Constitution is adhered to in all matters concerning the NSP.

## **The Vice-President**

The Vice-President shall be elected to a two-year term and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

The nominee for Vice-President shall have served at least one two-year term on the NSP National Board

The Vice-President shall be one of the four administrators of the APC and NSP Benevolent Fund. If so deemed by the four administrators, she shall be responsible for handling the Benevolent Fund Emergency and Reserve Accounts. The Vice-President implements the annual Benevolent Fund appeal and acknowledges each contributor.

The Vice-President must submit a report of income and expenditures of the APC/ NSP Benevolent fund at each NSP Board and Sisterhood general meeting.

The Vice-President may represent the President at any meeting or other function that the President cannot attend.

In the event the President is unable to complete her term, the Vice-President shall serve out the remainder of the President's term.

**Recording Secretary:**

The Recording Secretary shall be elected to a two-year term and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

The Recording Secretary shall be responsible for keeping the minutes of all NSP Board and NSP Conference Meetings.

The Recording Secretary shall make approved amendments to the Constitution.

**Corresponding Secretary:**

The Corresponding Secretary shall be elected to a two-year term and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

The Corresponding Secretary shall be responsible for all NSP correspondence, the NSP Newsletter, and keeping the NSP mailing list current.

The Corresponding Secretary shall be responsible for sending sympathy cards on behalf of the NSP to the family of a deceased family member.

**The Treasurer**

The Treasurer shall be elected to a two-year term and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining the NSP financial account(s). The Treasurer shall be chairman of the NSP Stewardship and shall maintain a record of donations.

The Treasurer shall submit a report of income and expenditures at each NSP Board Meeting and NSP Conference during the Archdiocesan Clergy Laity Congress.

The Treasurer shall be responsible for sending a donation in memory of a recently deceased Priest or Presvytera to the APC/NSP Benevolent Fund.
